



Requests to Visitors and a Note Regarding COVID-19 Countermeasures

[Requests to Visitors]

- We ask that you please wear a mask, disinfect your hands using alcohol for sterilization or another liquid, and take your body temperature.
- We ask that you maintain social distance from others (at least 1m).
- Visitors who exhibit the following symptoms will be refused entry.
 - Visitors whose body temperature is 37.5°C or higher
 - Visitors who exhibit cold symptoms (such as a fever, cough, sneezing or sore throat), a strong sense of fatigue, or difficulties breathing
 - Visitors with someone infected with COVID-19 or a high-risk contact close to them
 - Other visitors whose physical condition poses a concern

[Our Initiatives for Preventing COVID-19 Infection]

- We conduct tours on a reservation-only basis and in small groups.
- We have our employees wear masks, wash and disinfect their hands, and gargle.
- We have our employees fill out a “health observation check sheet” every time they report for work, and prohibit employees with health anomalies from working.
 - Anomalies include excessively high body temperature, an abnormal sense of taste or smell, a headache, joint pain, vomiting and diarrhea.
- We practicing social distancing and are careful to keep airborne droplets from coming in contact with others by setting up partitions.
- We regularly disinfect areas that people’s hands come in contact with, such as facilities and equipment (including tables, product shelves, bathrooms and manufacturing equipment).
